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The Eternal Love of God as Taught by Jesus

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Introduction

Many people are seeking wisdom about the questions of life. There are so many modern masters to read from. Men and women who have awoken deeply to their true nature, and the true nature of life. But I want to remind you of a man who lived centuries ago who taught us the true nature of reality. I want to remind you that there is a wealth of important information within the Gospels. I also want to remind you of the true nature of Jesus. When you read the Bible, try to look past the dogma of religion, and past any preconceived notions that you may have about the Bible. Try to see the truth that is there waiting to be plucked like jewels.

Few realize just how much support they have available to them. Everyone feels the call from within to find the answers to the issues they face in life. But few realize that all they have to do is ask for the truth, and it will be given to them. In reality, when you start to seek you are already asking indirectly by your desire to know. Or you are asking indirectly by any suffering you may be facing. And when you ask, you are always answered. You may not realize at first that you have been answered, but the answers always come.

Jesus

Jesus came among us as human a being to deliver to us the true nature and structure of reality. Within these teachings are the structure and hierarchy of heaven, the law of attraction, and the true eternal nature of God's love for us and all things. All of which have been expounded upon by modern masters of truth as well. Although Jesus was, and is more than a master of truth. In reality, there is a golden thread of truth that flows through all teachings, and all things. At the core, all there is one simple truth of life. This simple truth is abstracted through the infinite perception of souls living their material lives on earth.

When you finally seek deeply within yourself, you find the universal truth of reality. Then you look outwards again, and what you see is the same universal truth at the core of everything. You see this universal truth that is echoed within all religions, and all people, and all places. Everyone is perceiving this one simple truth according to their ability to receive. According to the clarity of their perception.

I will illustrate the true nature of Jesus's message as it was intended to be. I will also, through Jesus's teachings, illustrate the true nature of Jesus. Who Jesus really is and was when he walked in human form as a man. Many have heard Jesus's proclamation that no one comes to God except through him. This is a very important concept and often misunderstood. This verse illustrates who Jesus really is.

John 14:5-7

“5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know “him, and have seen him.” ¹

Here Jesus is telling us who he is. Jesus is the full and highest authority in heaven moving as one with God. All the authority of God flows first through Jesus, then through all the Angels and heavenly beings, then to us. When Jesus tells us that no one comes to God except through him, he is telling us that no matter how we seek God, or how we pray we go through him.

Jesus is telling us that there is one fundamental structure of heaven through which reality works. This doesn't mean that God won't accept us in any way we choose to come to God. There is always an open doorway to God. It only means that no matter how we pray and seek God, the structure of heaven is the same. And God wants us to know the structure of heaven as one body of God that is filled with specific roles and authorities.

God's Congregation

Jesus is one and the same as God, but is also himself as well. And this shines a light on the true nature of angels, and heavenly beings. It sheds light on our true nature. Another verse in the Bible illustrates this truth.

Psalm 82

"82 God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods." ²

Psalm 82

6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High." ³

In the Kingdom of God, there is a hierarchy. And God resides among this congregation, with Jesus beside him in authority. Then authority is delineated through Arch Angels, Angels, and eventually to us and physical reality. But we are all children of God. All the Angels and heavenly beings are children of God, and they all have specific roles to fill.

You have to remember these all are just names to represent these heavenly beings. The name Jesus only means savior, but Jesus is more than a name or a description. The same is true for Angels as well, and even us. I am using words and names to describe things that can't be described. These things must be interacted with and experienced to be truly be known.

We are also children of God, and we have specific roles to fill. Our role as spiritual children is education. For those who have seen Jesus, they have also seen God. But the same can be said for us. When you look into the faces of people around you, you are looking at God. And not just people around you, but all of material reality.

The Kingdom of God

This leads us to the structure of the Kingdom of God. Within this kingdom of God, there are many mansions. Jesus tells us in John 14:2, "2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you." ⁴

Within the Kingdom of God, everyone is regarded as equal among the others. Jesus, who is the highest authority, is no more or less than you and me as spiritual children. Even God is no more or less than any of us. Every part is equally and perfectly in its place, and shines with perfect brilliance and importance. God sees all of us as very important, just as we all see God as very important. When we awaken to our true nature, we take on this same true vision of equality. The true nature of reality.

But how does the Kingdom of God work? How does it bind and sustain all things? Again, Jesus tells us in the Gospel of Thomas.

The Gospel of Thomas

"(3) Jesus said, "If those who lead you say to you, 'See, the kingdom is in the sky,' then the birds of the sky will precede you. If they say to you, 'It is in the sea,' then the fish will precede you. Rather, the kingdom is inside of you, and it is outside of you. When you come to know yourselves, then you will become known, and you will realize that it is you who are the sons of the living father. But if you will not know yourselves, you dwell in poverty and it is you who are that poverty." ⁵

The Kingdom of God is like a web that connects, sustains, and binds all the living and nonliving aspects of material reality. The web through which we and all things are interconnected. In reality, we and all things are one unified structure. But even as we are one structure, we are also our individual selves. We only perceive the multiplicity of things in such a sharp way while in material reality. And this perception of multiplicity softens as we awaken to our true soul level perception. Within us, everything really exists as one singular whole. This one unified whole is the body of God.

When Jesus tells us that when we come to know ourselves, that we will know ourselves, he is referring to awakening to the true spiritual self within the material self. When you awaken to this spiritual self, then you will truly know yourself as you really are.

And before you awaken you are living in a state of poverty, not realizing the entire inheritance of heaven is yours.

Jesus knew all about awakening, and he knew that everyone in material reality was walking around oblivious to their true nature. Jesus often refers to people as walking around in a state of death while still being alive. This is because everyone has forgotten what they are as an eternal part of the body of God.

And because everyone has forgotten their true nature, they are oblivious to the fact that they are eternal. They are afraid of death, believing when they die they will cease to be. And not only that, they act according to the unawareness, living out of tune with their true nature, which is also God's true nature. The truth of God is our truth as well, because we are all a part of the body of God. God is reflected in us, and we are reflected in God. This is how and why we are made in the image of God. In reality every one of us is one with God, in just the same way that Jesus is one with God. We differ only in authority and magnitude.

John 17:14-26

“14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. 15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. 18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. 20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. 22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. 25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. 26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.”⁶

These verses are very powerful. Jesus wants us to know that we are all one with God, and also one with Jesus. And that we are one with each other, and all things. We are one with all the animals, and the natural world. God wants us to know the true nature of reality. But we have to choose. We will never be forced. These are our life lessons. And because we and all things are one, Jesus, God, and all the Angels and beings in heaven are with you now. All you ever have to do is ask.

Born Again

John 3:4-5

“4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.”⁷

Jesus is talking about awakening to your true nature, being reborn a second time back into your authentic perception as soul-level awareness. The water and spirit are terms for the truth of God. Being immersed and baptized within the river of God's truth, which shakes you awake to your true nature. As you awaken you begin to enter the Kingdom of God that is at hand. That has always been yours, but that you have only forgotten. This is also the deepest meaning behind the ceremony of baptism.

In this way, the truth of God brings you eternal life. Not because you were finite before you take in the truth of God, but because you have always been an eternal part of God. And as you awaken you realize yourself as that eternal part of God again, being born a second time into your true and rightful perception.

You are eternal, and always will be because you are an eternal part of God. But you will have to learn from your choices. Whether in the life you are living now, or after the end of your life, you will have to stand before God and Angels and confess all the choices you made in your life. This is why Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of God is at hand, and to repent now instead of waiting for the end of your life to stand naked before God as a pure soul level perception. God is eternal love and very wise, but we will be required to learn from our choices.

Free Will and Repentance

Matthew 4:17

“17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”⁸

It is very important to realize that the Kingdom of God is yours now. That this is your true nature. You are standing in heaven now. You never left heaven to get here. You will never fly away to some faraway heaven when you die. God and all of heaven are with you now, where you stand, and always have been. But you have to say yes to them. You hold yourself away from God and Heaven, not the other way around.

And this leads us to freedom of choice. You are free to choose whatever you want to choose. You will always be free to choose. God will never force you to choose anything, and that is a part of your education. It's within this free will that you are able to explore life, and all the consequences of your choices. And this process takes many lifetimes to complete. Jesus tells us about this in the following verse.

Mark 12:25

“25 For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven.”⁹

Always when Jesus is talking about resurrection, he is talking about the resurrection that takes place at the end of our lives. He is telling us we simply shake off our old physical form, and are resurrected as pure spirit awareness the same as the Angels. This is the true nature of life and death. Not that we die, and then wait for some far away judgment where some of us are cast into hell, and some of us are saved. When Jesus talks about the final judgment, he is referring to something much more realistic and aligned with the true eternal love of God.

You don't have to wait for the end of your life to have this death and rebirth. It can happen now. You can awaken and leave the old false self behind. You can be reborn as your true spirit level perception now, while still within the life you are living now. Again, you can see why it's so important to seek God and to awaken now. You can have your whole life fully aware that you are in, and made of heaven, and not just as a concept within your material

mind. But deeply experienced and perceived from the spirit level awareness and perception, regaining your true and rightful identity.

Final Judgment

Revelation 20:11-12

“11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.”¹⁰

When we die our physical form falls away. We are left as pure spirit awareness, and in that instant, we suddenly know and see our true nature and the true nature of God. Even if we denied God through our whole lives, we will suddenly see the truth of the matter. The book of life is the record of all the choices we ever made. And we stand before God and Angels and are judged according to the choices we made in the life we just lived. All of which is recorded in the book of life.

We are then required to come back to live another life based on those choices. We come eagerly and willingly. We always have a choice. According to some choices we previously made, we may have a hard test before us to learn and atone for what we have done. But we are never destroyed. And this cycle goes on and on until finally in one lifetime we graduate from this cycle of reincarnation. When that graduation occurs, we are allowed to break the cycle of our education and to stay in the Kingdom of God.

We won't be required to come again, but we may for various reasons. But our education doesn't end there. We are growing up into spiritual adults where we begin to step into Angel's roles in the Kingdom of God. Supporting souls who are living earthly lives, or other roles that support heavenly and earthly life. Education never stops.

You can see the importance of repenting and seeking God and your true nature. To master your life lessons. We attract to us the lessons we need most to learn. And we will repeat lessons until we master them and move on to a new lesson. This is the law of attraction. Jesus told the Centurion in Matthew 8:13, “13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.”¹¹

The Hidden Places

What you believe, and the patterns of awareness you habitually entertain will attract to you similar events and things within the world. This is so that you can learn from your choices. And so that you can ultimately learn to master yourself in only thoughts and patterns of awareness that match your true nature, and the true nature of God.

What you hold in the hidden places always becomes apparent in your life. The old saying, “As above, so below” ¹², stands just as true here with Jesus’s teachings as anywhere else and is reflected in the Bible. In Luke 12:3 it is written, “3 Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.” ¹³

Guard the hidden places of your mind. Master your thoughts and do nothing with your thinking mind you wouldn't openly do before others, or that you wouldn't openly do before God. What is hidden will always manifest, so be clean all the way through mind, body, and spirit.

God only ever wants to give you everything. God wants you to be your whole and true self, but you have to choose. You will never be forced to choose what is true. It is the interplay between your spirit level wisdom and the distracting and challenging nature of material reality that makes you grow. But in no way will we ever be thrown away or cast out from God. God’s love is eternal. God always accepts us, either in this life or the next, but it is much better to come to God now and ask for repentance and the truth than to wait for the end of your life. Because God is calling you even now, and do you want to stand before God after your life and have to explain why you didn’t listen?

The Love of God

Jesus tells us about the true nature of God's love in the following passages.

Matthew 5:43-48

“43 Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbor, and hate thine enemy. 44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; 45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? Do not even the publicans the same? 47 And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? 48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.”¹⁴

These verses tell the true story of God. Jesus who is the full authority and reflection of God's truth was telling us how God perceives and handles his children. God's truth is all about eternal loving patience and compassion, but also wise judgment that's intended to teach us the truth of reality, and not to strike fear into our hearts. God is a kind, wise, and very loving parent.

Jesus tells us to love our enemies. He tells us this because he knows that everyone is unaware of their true identity, and on the path to learning the fullness of the truth of God and reality. When you forgive those who trespass against you, you are taking the higher awareness and the unaware and harmful actions that are directed towards you, whatever they may be, are stopped in their tracks by you. The unawareness is not transferred to you. Instead, you must love and forgive them, because you in your deeper understanding and awareness can see just how much they are lost and confused. And how then can you ever step into the same unawareness in return? You would be taking on the same folly yourself. Love you enemies because there are no enemies. Only misguided souls.

In this way you are a true reflection of God's truth. Because this is the same way God views us. With deep understanding, compassion and wisdom. God shines his loving truth on the just and the unjust knowing seeing deeply to the core of all that takes place. Seeing things as they truly are, and you can share this same vision with God. This vision is in reality

your true and authentic vision. You gain this wisdom by awakening to your true nature. And you awaken by asking God for truth. By seeking truth.

Now you are beginning to understand the true nature of God. How everything in life is there for a reason and purpose. Can you imagine a God who is so loving wise and compassionate ever casting away his children? Ever leaving them to burn and be tortured in hell? God who teaches to love your enemies, and to turn the other cheek? Who teaches to forgive those who trespass against you? All things are taking place to teach us our lessons. We are eternal soul level awareness within our material forms. One life would never be enough to teach us all we need to know. Material life must be sharp and strong to teach us our lessons. And this is the perfection of God's plan. As you begin to see this golden truth within all that takes place, your suffering begins to fall away, replaced by a divine acceptance of the perfection within all things.

Just Ask

John 14:12-15

“12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.”¹⁵

All you ever have to do is ask. God, Jesus, and all of heaven are just waiting at your door. All you have to do is believe. You must talk to God and ask God to show you what is true. So many spiritual teachers miss this point. That all you have to do is ask. Jesus tells us in Matthew 7:7 “7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:”¹⁶

This leads to the true nature of prayer. Because we are all a part of the same Body of God, interconnected by the same spirit of God, we have a direct channel to God. And not only to God but also to Jesus, Angels, and each other. Within us, we are this soul-level perception that is beyond the thinking mind, and body. We are the awareness that is perceiving all things, not that which is perceived.

Because we are in reality soul level perception within our material forms, on the fundamental level we communicate through pure perception. This communication through pure perceiving awareness has been called psychic phenomena, but really it is only the basic way we all have always communicated. We all have only forgotten that it is possible and is there. When we pray, we are communicating inwards through our interconnection with the Body of God's spirit to God through psychic awareness.

This is the true nature of prayer. And it's the way God speaks to us as well. There is two-way communication. This communication is taking place all the time, you just don't realize that it is. God is and has been speaking and suggesting truth into your heart all through your life, and always will. But are you listening? You won't be forced.

And this leads us to your heart. Your heart is where you feel the communication with God. God's voice comes as feeling into your heart. It flows into your heart from within where

you then can process it with your material mind and body. This communication is something that has always been there, and is experienced in your heart as an earthly human. At first, you will have to practice recognizing the answers to your prayers. You will have to remember how to communicate in this way again. But with persistence, you will be shown again and again that you are being spoken to. And that you are being guided.

Prayers Answered

God communicates both directly into your heart, or through Angels. Angels are God's order of workers and messengers. God and Angels will often begin by communicating with us through the world we are so focused on. They know we are always looking at cell phones and computer screens. They know we are always looking outwards, and rarely inwards to the Kingdom of God. You will begin to see repeating numbers all around you in the world. 1111, 2222, 3333, 4444, and so on. Sometimes the numbers may be something that you will notice like your birthday.

You may also see signs that stand out to you. Symbols and shapes that hold specific meaning to you or the questions you are asking God. It's even possible for God to make words people are saying or words from a TV playing near you stand out to you. God may communicate to you through the natural world. You may see specific creatures or any natural things that holds specific meaning to you.

They are trying to get your attention. Also, when you start seeking, God will lead you to books, and websites where information that you are seeking is written. Just like you are reading this web page right now. It is very important that you persist and have faith. Never give up seeking God's truth, which is also your truth. You will be guided again and again. What could be more important than to be free as your most authentic self?

And this leads me into my two final verses for now. I am repeating a verse I shared before because of its importance. Mathew 7:7, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you"¹⁷ Ask and keep asking. Never be turned away by a doubting mind. Keep reaching for truth. One of the most powerful things you can ever ask for is to know the truth.

John 8:32

"32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."¹⁸
